Application Customization Stockpile Dressta's crawler dozers have a stockpile compaction feature package that has been built to manage tricky job situations including sloped and unstable work environments. This SFR equipment has a heavy-duty Dressta steel drum along with a winch line attachment with brackets attached to the drum. The tensioning system prevents the line from touching the slope face. These crawler dozers evenly distribute their weight to ensure stability and balance.

Fire Tractor Dozers This range of tractor dozers are ideal machines for preventing, cleaning up and containing forest fires. These units are perfect for working around heavy ash, fallen trees, burning sap, dirt and airborne sand. Fire crews utilize this equipment for clearing paths, establishing fire lines and removing combustible items.
